

Japonica Zenith Zoysia is of a light green colour, resistant to the shade. It requires little maintenance and hardly any chemical treatment, as well as being resistant to plagues and insects. It has few watering needs and can go without its water supply in times of drought without permanently damaging the grass. The success of this variety is tested and is a factor which thrives in areas where others cannot, mainly in shaded areas.
